

ADEPT EXHIBITS

During spring/summer 2011 ADEPT's holistic architecture and visionary city planning can be experienced in three exhibition halls: Utzon Center, SHIP and Louisiana Art Museum.

Since its establishment in 2006 ADEPT has asserted itself on the Danish and international scene of architecture. Large and small scale projects – from master plans, high-rise and urban space designs to educational and cultural buildings – are tied together by holistic and forward-looking solutions to present and future urban challenges.

ADEPT's success kicked off after winning international competitions for Denmark's Most Beautiful High-Rise and new Art Academy in Reykjavik, Iceland. Among the office's latest winning proposals are House of Culture and Movement and a multimedia library for Dalarna University in Sweden (construction begins this summer). Common to both projects is a reinterpretation of space for social life and diversity as well as a synergy between city and building. This is also true of their winning projects in planning and urban space design; e.g. master plan H+ for a 100HA new city and residential area in Helsingborg and the recreational axis, Måløv Axis, winner of Danish Landscape Award 2010.

The following three exhibitions invite the public to gain an insight into the approach and processes behind ADEPT's planning, urban design and architecture.

Utzon Center — We Love the City

We Love the City focuses attention on the experience and development of the city. The exhibition is a laboratory of ADEPT's experimental approach to creating synergy between architecture and city planning. With the slogan "the City in the Building and the Building in the City" ADEPT involves visitors in their passion for and work as urbanists and shows thought-provoking strategies and prize-winning projects for the future of architecture.

SHIP — Think H+

Think H+ presents concept and strategies for the development of the future H+ area in the southern part of Helsingborg. In 2009 ADEPT won, in collaboration with Schønherr landscape architects, the competition for H+ with the project The Tolerant City. The focal point is a huge model (6x6 m²) for the H+ master plan surrounded by descriptions and images of the many comprehensive investigations and studies underlying the development of H+ over the next 20 years.

Think H+ is arranged by Helsingborg Municipality. H+ mega model is designed and developed by ADEPT and Schønherr. The exhibition is on-going at SHIP, Bredgatan 11, 252 25 Helsingborg — <http://hplus.helsingborg.se> From April 27th the H+ mega model will be included in the exhibition and the H+ manual is distributed.

Louisiana — LIVING

LIVING is Louisiana Art Museum's third exhibition in the series "the Boundaries of Architecture". With a focus on the reimposition of human scale in architecture the exhibition investigates the potential of architecture to generate new values and ways of living in the 21st century. Sky Village project, by ADEPT in collaboration with Dutch MVRDV, is featured as part of a theme investigating the idea of the individual in relation to the community, and the cell in relation to a network of cells. Sky Village is a 22.000m² high-rise located in Rødovre, a suburb of Copenhagen. The building is based on a flexible grid-system and combines two typologies existing today in Rødovre - single-family housing and the high-rise – contained in a vertical structure.
